New Car Park Permit Scheme

From 1 September, the PCC has decided to introduce a car parking permit scheme for our car park. We have had several local residents park in the car park over the years and more recently some of them are either difficult to contact when we need their vehicles moved or they have not moved them when requested, blocking access for others. The permit scheme aims to address this while also seeking to maintain good relationships with our closest neighbours. The permits are specifically meant for those who use are car park but who are not attending services, events or activities in the church or the centre. Anyone who comes to a service or event or is hiring the church or centre **does not** require a permit. We have also an ongoing arrangement with Rumboldswhyke School for parents to be able to use the car park during term time for drop off and pick up.
